YOUTH ONLY RABBIT/POULTRY SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Only YOUTH may enter the Columbia County Fair Poultry/Rabbit Show. No adult entries.**
- All entries must be submitted **no later than October 21, 2019** to the Columbia County Fair Office no later than 5:00pm. Any exception/questions should be directed to Norma Padgett at npadgett@windstream.net. **DUE TO CAGE LIMITATIONS EXHIBITORS WILL BE ALLOWED A MAXIMUM OF 2 RABBITS AND MUST PROVIDE FEED AND WATER DISHES FOR RABBITS.**
- All animals will be checked in on **Monday, October 28, 2019, between 1:00pm and 4:00pm.**
- All animals will be released Saturday, November 2, 2019, between 9:00pm and 10:00pm.** Exhibitors must arrive no later than 10:00pm to **pick up their animals.** Exhibitors will not be allowed to enter the livestock gate before 10:00pm to pick up animals. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Exhibitors must make their own arrangements for delivery and pick up of animals. Any exhibit left after the date and time set for pick-up will automatically become the property of the Columbia County Fair Association.
- Animals will not be allowed to be placed in cage until checked by the superintendent. All poultry will be tested for negative pullorum-typhoid through a blood test unless registered with the NPIP. A state veterinarian will be available at check in only. All rabbits will be checked by Superintendent for signs of disease, lice, mites or fleas. Superintendent reserves the right to refuse any animal showing signs of illness or bugs.
- ONLY ONE (1) EXHIBIT WILL BE PLACED IN EACH CAGE UNLESS APPROVED BY SUPERINTENDANT. PLEASE CHECK WITH SUPERINTENDANT IF YOU NEED ADDITIONAL CAGES.**
- The Fair Association will provide feed, water and care for all animals during the week of the fair.
