Freestyle Requirements

Freestyle not only provides contestants an opportunity to showcase a set of horsemanship maneuvers creatively, but it also allows a rider to expand those maneuvers to music by means of choreography. Riders are encouraged to use musical pieces (songs) which will permit them to show the athletic ability of the horse and rider in a crowd appealing way. Contestants will be scored based on their horsemanship, completing required maneuvers, staying within the time limit and creativity/originality of the freestyle. You will need to turn in your music and a sequenced plan of the maneuvers you will perform during your freestyle when you turn in your paperwork.

Required Maneuvers:

- A minimum of two turns or spins to the right.
- A minimum of two turns or spins to the left.
- A minimum of three stops.
- A minimum of one lead change at the canter from right to left.
- A minimum of one lead change at the canter from left to right.

Time Limit:

A maximum of four minutes for the choreographed freestyle.

The time limit will be from the beginning of the music.

Costumes:

Permitted and will be a part of the “Originality/Creativity” score.

Props:

Permitted and if used will be part of the (Originality/Creativity” score.

Failure to perform all the required maneuvers or failure to complete the freestyle within the time limit will result in a score of zero for that maneuver.

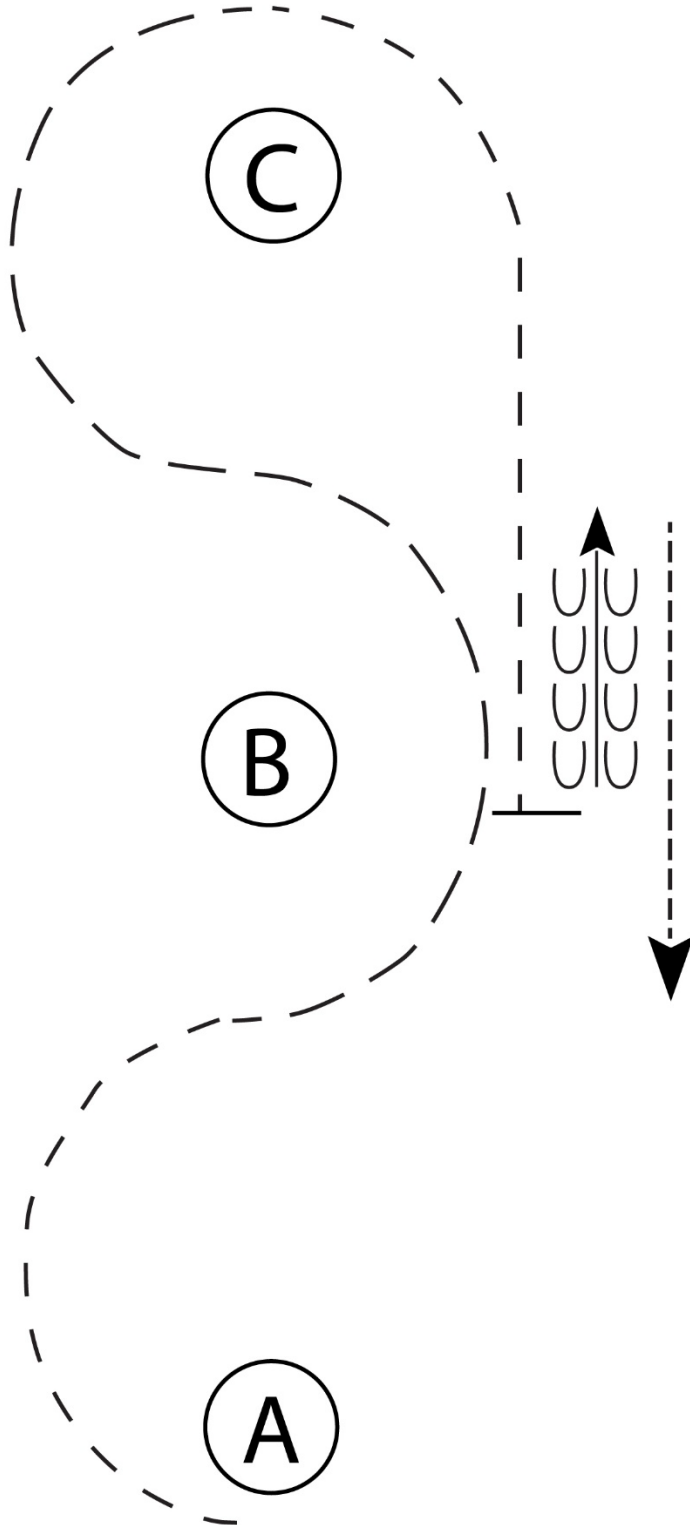

Patterns – Little Miss

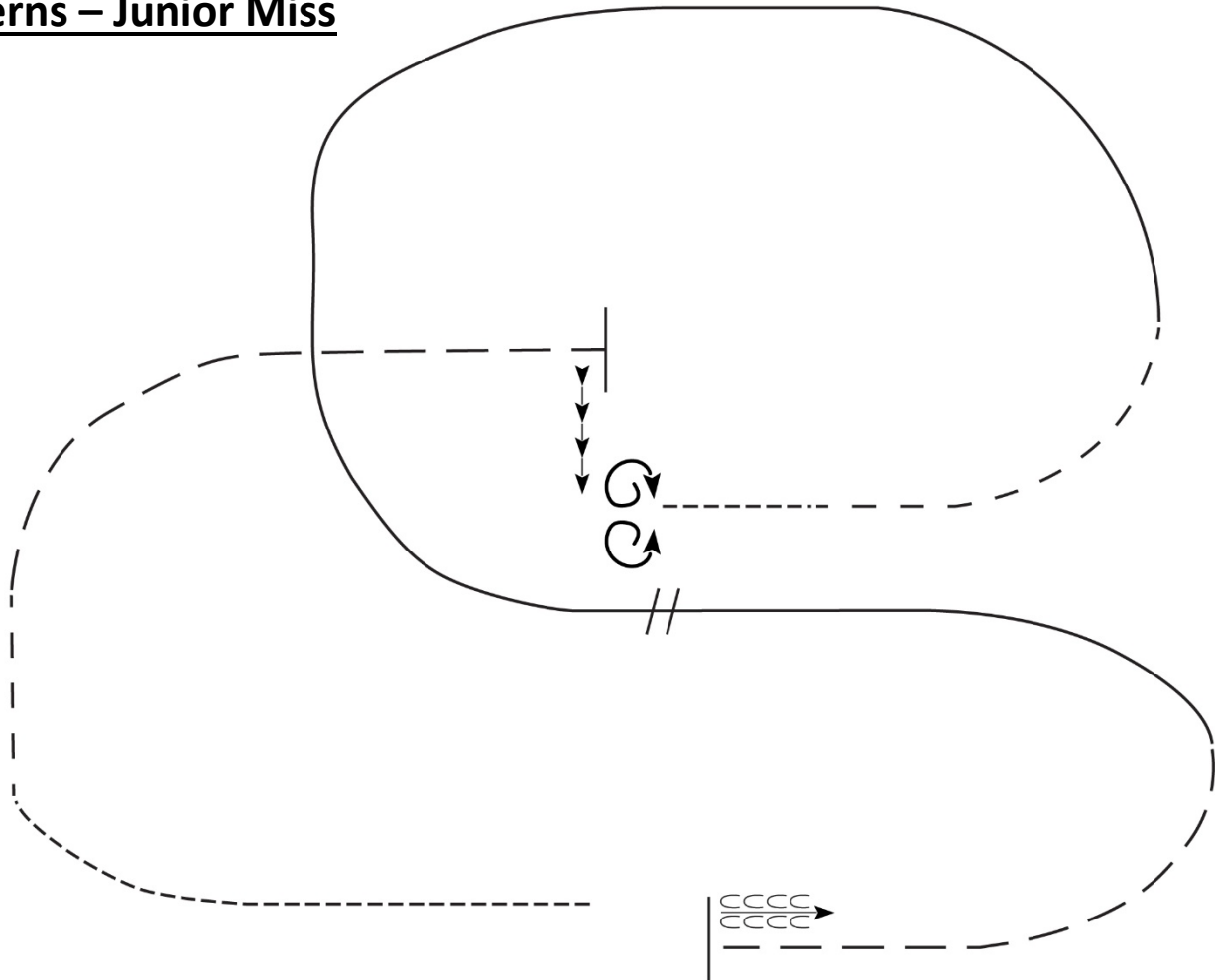


Be ready at A.

1. Jog in a half circle until between A and B.
2. Extend the jog around B and C as shown
2. Slow to a jog and jog until even with B.
4. Stop and back approximately one horse length.
5. Walk straight away.

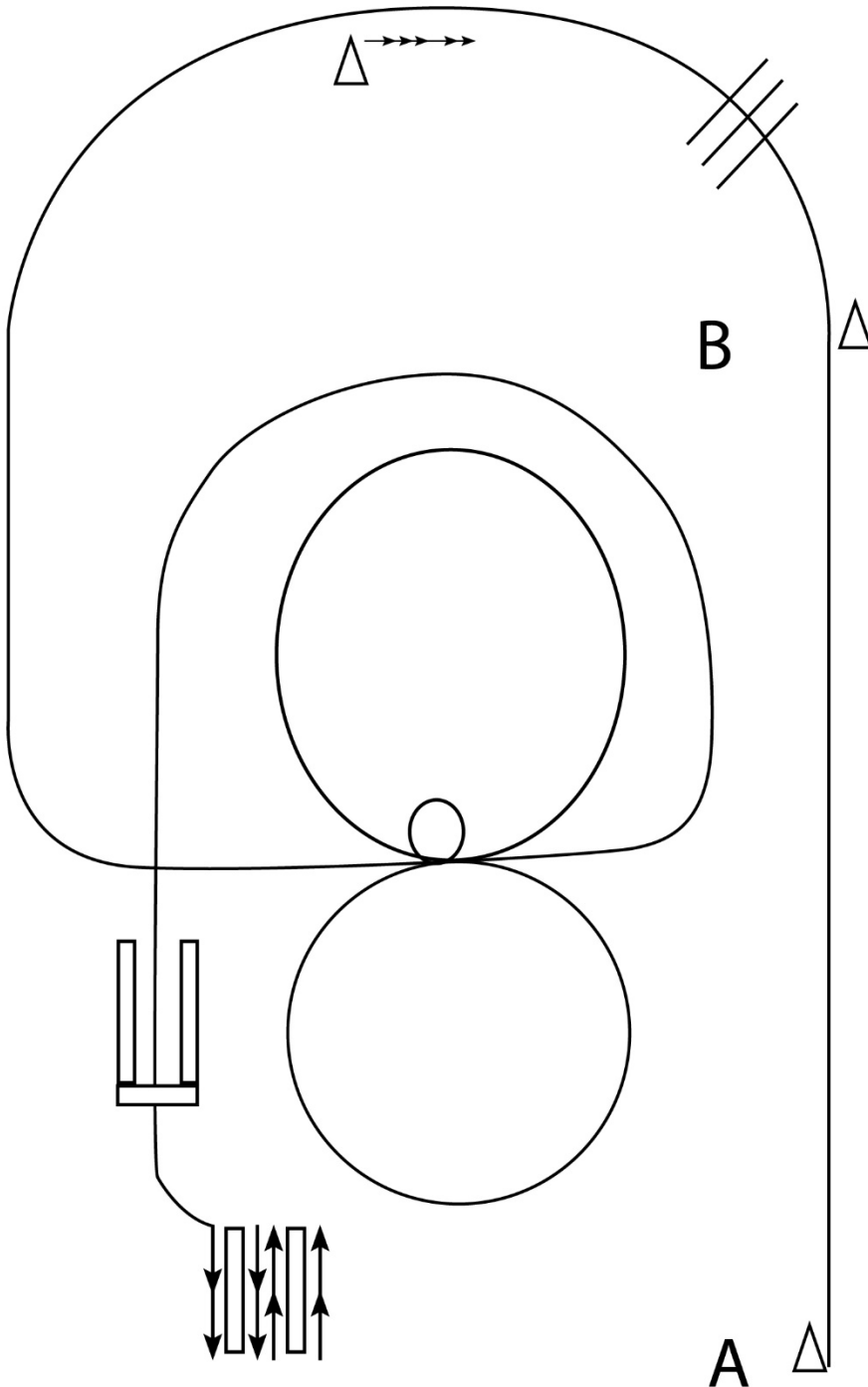
Patterns – Junior Miss



1. Walk to the left around corner of arena
2. Trot
3. Extend alongside of the arena and around the corner to the center
4. Stop, side pass right
5. 360 Degree turn each direction (either way 1st)
6. Walk
7. Trot
8. Lope left lead
9. Extend the lope
10. Change leads (simple or flying)
11. Collect to the lope
12. Extend trot
13. Stop and back

Patterns – Miss



1. Left lead lope A to B.
2. At B break to a trot.
3. Cross over poles.
4. Trot to next cone and stop.
5. Back 5 steps.
6. Left lead lope to center, small slow circle.
7. Stop.
8. 2 spins left.
9. Right lead lope small slow; in center change to left lead.
10. Continue to lope left lead into chute; in chute transition to walk.
11. Walk to log and side pass right.
12. Side pass left.
