Young ladies in the Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo Pageant will be judged on their horsemanship skills, poise, and public speaking ability. All contestants are expected to exhibit exceptional sportsmanship, adhere to the humane treatment of animals, and comport with high moral and ethical standards (act in an appropriate manner, no behavior or electronic communication that may reflect negatively on the Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo or Columbia County Resources).

Miss Photogenic Contest:

All contestants may enter the Miss Photogenic competition. Contestants wishing to participate must submit a **5x7 headshot in Western Attire (color or black and white) with a \$10 entry fee. No glamour or professional shots allowed. DUE FEBRUARY 20, 2026.**

Each contestants must email a photo to info@floridagatewayfairgrounds.org for the newspaper by **FEBRUARY 20, 2026**. This can be the same photo that is submitted for the Photogenic contest. Must submit a photo in western attire.

Awards:

Miss Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo

The winner of the Miss Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo receives a \$300 educational scholarship, tiara, buckle, and sash. First runner up receives a \$150 educational scholarship and a recognition award.

Jr. Miss, and Little Miss Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo

The winners of each division receive a tiara, buckle and sash. The first runner up in each division receives a recognition award.

Miss Photogenic

The winner receives a special award. (Please note: More than one winner may be selected depending on number of entries.)

Pageant Rules:

- Contestants must be Florida residents.
- Entry deadline is Feb. 20th 2026 at 4:00 p.m.
- Photo deadline is Feb. 20th 2026 at 4:00 p.m.
- Late fee of \$25.00 up to Feb. 27th 2026.
- Western attire must be worn at all times during competition and Rodeo.
- Contestants must be currently enrolled in school or be in a receipt of a high diploma or equivalent.
- Contestants must reside in Columbia County or one of these listed: Baker, Union, Alachua, Levy, Dixie, Gilchrist, Layfayette, Suwannee, Madison and Hamilton.
- Miss FGPR is required to ride a horse all three days at the Florida Gateway Pro Rodeo. All contestants age 10 & up are required to ride a horse during the grand entry on March 13th. Little Miss is not required to ride.
- Contestants must be single, have never been married or divorced, must not be pregnant or become pregnant during the coming year, and may not be the mother of a child conceived out of wedlock.
- Reigning Queens cannot compete for a crown in the same division in which they currently hold their title. A reigning Queen may only participate in the Queen competition if they meet the age requirements for a different division. Other wise, the reigning Queen must sit out one year before they are eligible to compete again in the same division.
- Contestants are responsible to have a horse available to them for all practices and all performances.
- Both Miss and Jr. Miss division contestants may be required to perform a flag drill and a queen run during the competition.
- No lead lines.
- Each contestant must obtain a minimum of \$200 in sponsorships.
- Columbia County Resources and the Judges reserve the right to modify any rules, patterns or drills before or during this competition.
- All contestants are required to complete a Horsemanship pattern. (Patterns can be printed at www.FGFair.org or picked up from FGF Office.)
- Miss and Jr. Miss division contestants may bring and ride multiple horses during the competition.

Competition to begin in the Reception Hall at the Florida Gateway Fairgrounds with the interviews. You do not need to be at the interviews for the whole time, you just need to be there for your designated time of your age group.


IMPORTANT:
