- Senior High School Student
- Minimum 3.5 GPA
- Must be affiliated with Columbia County Resources or a livestock exhibitor.
- Must be a legal resident of the United States.
- Must complete application.
- Must provide three letters of recommendation with application.
- Must submit a 500-word essay (minimum) in YOUR own words to describe your personal vision of Agriculture Business as it related to your future career goals.
- Must provide sealed transcripts from the school.
- Winners must provide proof of college class registration to receive scholarship funds.
- Deadline is October 7, 2022
