Schools are responsible for providing and setting up their own display materials (easels, display panels, racks, etc.). Please do not affix or attach anything to the curtains.

Each booth measures 10' wide × 8' deep.

Please submit your booth request by September 25, 2026. Booth space is limited and assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Email forms to info@floridagatewayfairgrounds.org. Faxed forms **WILL NOT be accepted.**

Set up will be Monday, October 26th – Thursday, October 29th, 9:00am to 5:00pm.

Doors will not open again until October 30th at 5:00pm at the opening of the fair.

You will have Monday, November 9th and Tuesday, November 10th between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm to break down your booth.

Any article not claimed by Tuesday, November 10th at 5:00pm will become property of the Florida Gateway Fair Board. **Please note you will not be able to take down anything in your booth before Monday, November 9th at 9:00am.*

Should the Fair exercise its rights to cancel this License for any reason, including but not limited to those stated above, Licensee agrees to forego any, and all claims for damages against The Fair and further agrees to waive any, and all rights which might arise by reason of the terms of this License and the Licensee shall have no recourse of any kind against the Fair.
