



## DIVISION VII

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### ***BAKED GOODS***

#### ***SPECIAL RULES: Bring entries and recipes***

1. Exhibits will be Thursday, October 29th, 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.
2. Judging will take place on Friday, October 30th, using the Modified Danish System.
3. Items must be on disposable bases
4. Exhibit item must be labeled and recipe attached to bottom. All items MUST have Name, Address, Phone Number
5. Any person employed in a bake shop and wishing to exhibit articles will be judged in a separate category.
6. All articles must be clean and in good condition.
7. Only one (1) entry, per LOT number, per individual will be accepted.
8. No item will be accepted for judging that has previously been exhibited at the Florida Gateway Fair.
9. NO premium will be awarded when exhibit is regarded as unworthy.
10. All items MUST have Name, Address, Phone Number and Item description securely attached.
11. Premiums will not be paid without ALL correct information filled in on ALL registration forms.
12. All checks for premium monies awarded in connection with the fair shall be negotiated by the recipient/payee within 60 days from the date of the check: time being of the essence. If the recipient/payee fails to timely negotiate said check, all monies due recipient/payee shall belong to the fair and the recipient/payee shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said monies to the fair.
13. A BEST OF CLASS will be chosen from the blue ribbon winners in each Class accompanied by a \$10.00 premium. From the BEST OF CLASS in each given Division a BEST OF SHOW will be chosen, accompanied by a \$25.00 premium.
14. From the BEST OF SHOW winners - one (1) BEST OVERALL will be chosen, accompanied by a \$50.00 premium.
15. Exhibits may be picked up on November 9th following the Fair, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.

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### JUDGING STANDARDS

1. General Appearance
2. Frosting or crust
3. Lightness
4. Grain
5. Texture
6. Flavor

1. Contestants must be amateurs. Chefs, Cooks or Culinary Arts Students are not eligible.
2. Contestants may have more than one entry, but can only win one (1) prize.
3. Submissions must be home cooked (not store bought).
4. Types of desserts that may be entered: a. Cakes b. Cookies c. Brownies d. Pies
5. Please do not submit anything that requires refrigeration.
6. All submissions will become property of Columbia County Resources.
7. Contestants may work individually or with a team.
8. Contestants should not fraternize with the judges.
